#### **OUR MISSION**

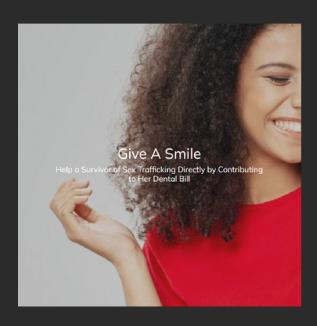
Our mission is to lead society through a transformative journey from awareness to advocacy by challenging the norms for a world free of human trafficking.

We believe that the key to advancing the Movement against human trafficking is to empower society with information, action opportunities, and stories that inspire change and compassion. We continuously search for opportunities to engage new communities.



#### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

**redM Member Events:** Our members host events focused on empowering new communities as seen in our Cultural Night series. In 2023, we organized four major events, each drawing over 300 participants from unique communities. We continued to host free information sessions building our knowledge about the realities of human trafficking.

**redM Partner Events:** We support our partners' events by leveraging our extensive network of sponsors, attendees, and volunteers. In 2023, we supported three significant partner events, providing our members with valuable opportunities to witness the support systems in place for survivors.

redM Collaborations: We actively seek connections with established network groups to expand the reach of our vision. In 2023, we successfully collaborated with many organizations, including OGGN, Social Octane, a Cup of Joey, the Society of Low Carbon Technologies, and the International Association of Drilling Contractors. We also engaged many industry trafficking awareness groups, including the clean energy community. Additionally, we increased our involvement with United Against Human Trafficking as a key coalition member.

The Art of Overcoming	\$13,955	With over 300 attendees, this event was a spectacular introduction and launch of our new partner, Twelve 11, an organization dedicated to helping overcomers thrive after rescue.
Spanish Night to Remember	\$9,989	The second annual Spanish Night to Remember continued to actively engage Houston's theater community while using the art of flamenco dancing to advance the Movement.
Scottish Night to Remember	\$10,173	Endorsed by the Scottish government, this unique event engaged the Energy Industry by showcasing new technology and spotlighting Scotland's deep connection to freedom and the energy transition.
Venezuelan Night to Remember	\$7,836	This sold-out event highly engaged Houston's Latino community, including media coverage on Univision while raising awareness about the terrible impact of human trafficking in Venezuela and other parts of the world.

Conscious Leadership: This series, initiated in 2022, continued with the final session of the three-part training series and an additional session presented at the Offshore Technology Conference. Conscious Leadership inspires members with a dynamic leadership style that progresses through self-discovery, expanding to your circle, and ultimately to the community, fostering personal and collective growth.
